

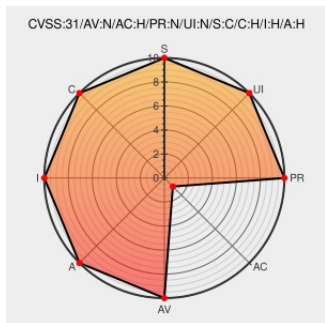

Certain versions of [Securmail](#) from [Securenvoy](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SecurEnvoy SecurMail 9.3.503 allows attackers to upload executable files and achieve OS command execution via a crafted SecurEnvoyReply cookie.

CVE-2020-13376 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
