

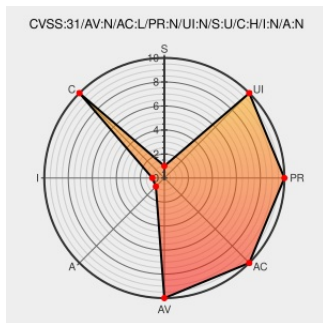

Certain versions of [Microweber](#) from [Microweber](#) contain the following vulnerability:

userfiles/modules/users/controller/controller.php in Microweber before 1.1.20 allows an unauthenticated user to disclose the users database via a /modules/ POST request.

CVE-2020-13405 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
