

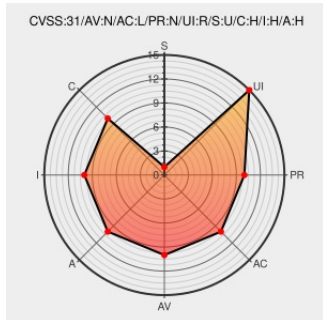

Certain versions of [Drupal](#) from [Drupal](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Request Forgery vulnerability in Drupal Core Form API does not properly handle certain form input from cross-site requests, which can lead to other vulnerabilities.
