

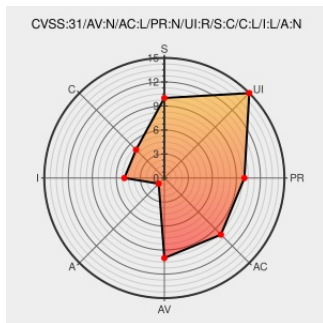

Certain versions of [Navigate Cms](#) from [Naviwebs](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Navigate CMS through 2.8.7. It allows XSS because of a lack of purify calls in lib/packages/feeds/feed.class.php.

CVE-2020-13798 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
