

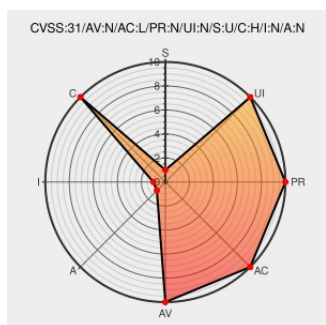

Certain versions of [Dext5](#) from [Dext5](#) contain the following vulnerability:

handler/upload_handler.jsp in DEXT5 Editor through 3.5.1402961 allows an attacker to download arbitrary files via the savefilepath field.

CVE-2020-13894 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
