Certain versions of [Monstra Cms](#) from [Monstra](#) contain the following vulnerability:

**** DISPUTED **** Monstra CMS 3.0.4 allows an attacker, who already has administrative access to modify `.chunk.php` files on the Edit Chunk screen, to execute arbitrary OS commands via the Theme Module by visiting the `admin/index.php?id=themes&action=edit_chunk` URI.

NOTE: there is no indication that the Edit Chunk feature was intended to prevent an administrator from using PHP's `exec` feature.

CVE-2020-13978 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
