

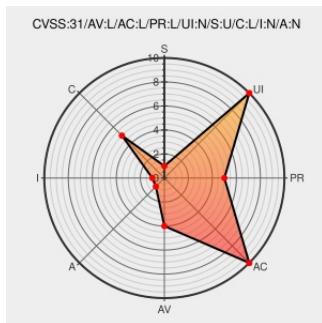

Certain versions of [Ansible Tower](#) from [Redhat](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A flaw was found in Ansible Tower in versions before 3.7.2. A Server Side Request Forgery flaw can be abused by supplying a URL which could lead to the server processing it connecting to internal services or exposing additional internal services and more particularly retrieving full details in case of error. The highest threat from this vulnerability is

to data confidentiality.

CVE-2020-14328 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
