

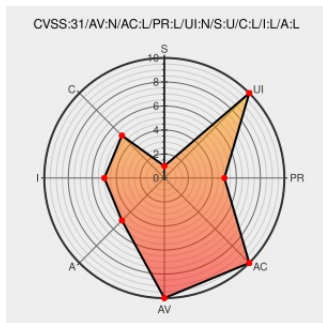

Certain versions of [Openclinic Ga](#) from [Openclinic Ga Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An attacker may bypass permission/authorization checks in OpenClinic GA 5.09.02 and 5.89.05b by ignoring the redirect of a permission failure, which may allow unauthorized execution of commands.

CVE-2020-14486 has been assigned by [ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
