

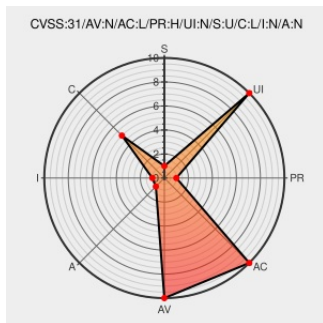

Certain versions of [Applications Framework](#) from [Oracle](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Vulnerability in the Oracle Applications Framework product of Oracle E-Business Suite (component: Page Request). Supported versions that are affected are 12.1.3 and 12.2.3-12.2.9. Easily exploitable vulnerability allows high privileged attacker with network access via HTTP to compromise Oracle Applications Framework. Successful

attacks of this vulnerability can result in unauthorized read access to a subset of Oracle Applications Framework accessible data. CVSS 3.1 Base Score 2.7 (Confidentiality impacts). CVSS Vector: (CVSS:3.1/AV:N/AC:L/PR:H/UI:N/S:U/C:L/I:N/A:N).

CVE-2020-14590 has been assigned by secalert_us@oracle.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
