

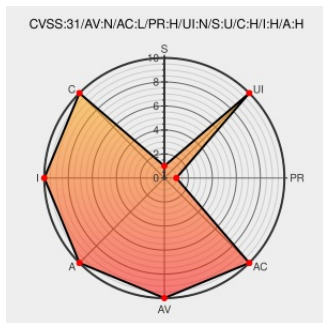

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## CVE-2020-15308

Certain versions of [Support Incident Tracker](#) from [Turnkeylinux](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Support Incident Tracker (aka SiT! or SiTracker) 3.67 p2 allows post-authentication SQL injection via the site\_edit.php typeid or site parameter, the search\_incidents\_advanced.php search\_title parameter, or the report\_qbe.php criteriafield parameter.

CVE-2020-15308 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
