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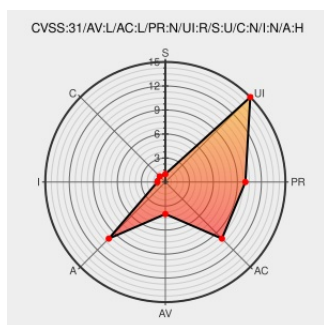

Certain versions of [Whoopsie](#) from [Whoopsie Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The `parse_report()` function in `whoopsie.c` in Whoopsie through 0.2.69 mishandles memory allocation failures, which allows an attacker to cause a denial of service via a malformed crash file.

CVE-2020-15570 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
