

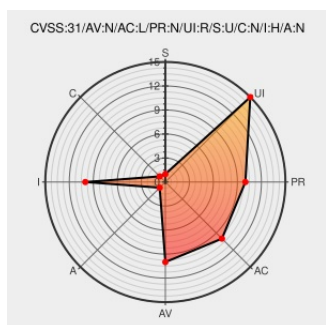

Certain versions of [Cmsuno](#) from [Cmsuno Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in CMSUno before 1.6.1. uno.php allows CSRF to change the admin password.

CVE-2020-15600 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
