

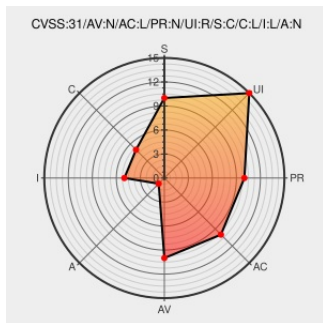

Certain versions of [Joomla!](#) from [Joomla](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Joomla! through 3.9.19. Lack of input filtering and escaping allows XSS attacks in mod_random_image.

CVE-2020-15696 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
