

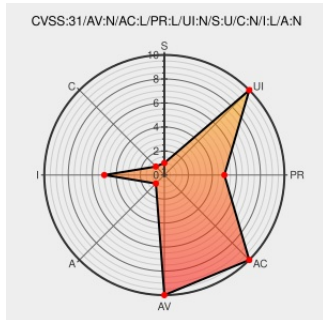

An issue was discovered in Joomla! through 3.9.19. Internal read-only fields in the User table class could be modified by users.
