

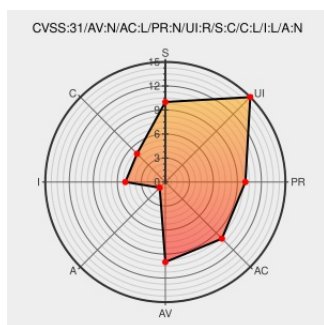

A Reflected Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability was discovered in Mida eFramework through 2.9.0.
