

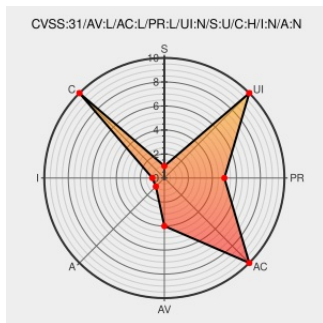

Certain versions of [Keycloak](#) from [Redhat](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A flaw was found in keycloak in versions before 9.0.0. A logged exception in the HttpMethod class may leak the password given as parameter. The highest threat from this vulnerability is to data confidentiality.

CVE-2020-1698 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
