

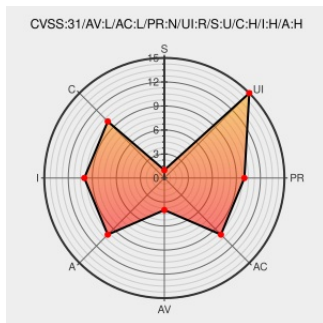

Certain versions of [Windows 10](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A remote code execution vulnerability exists in the way that Microsoft Windows Codecs Library handles objects in memory, aka 'Microsoft Windows Codecs Library Remote Code Execution Vulnerability'.

CVE-2020-17022 has been assigned by secure@microsoft.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
