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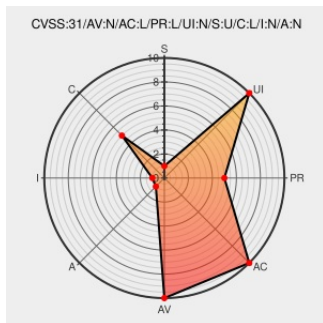

Certain versions of Moodle from Moodle contain the following vulnerability:

In Moodle before 3.8.2, 3.7.5, 3.6.9 and 3.5.11, users viewing the grade history report without the 'access all groups' capability were not restricted to viewing grades of users within their own groups.

CVE-2020-1754 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
