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Certain versions of [Mipcms](#) from [Mipcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability in MIPCMS 3.6.0 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via the category name field to categoryEdit.

CVE-2020-18132 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
