

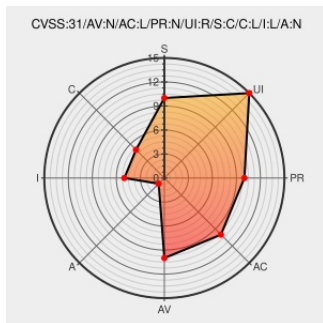

Cross Site Scripting vulnerability found in Phodal CMD v.1.0 allows a local attacker to execute arbitrary code via the EMBED SRC function.
