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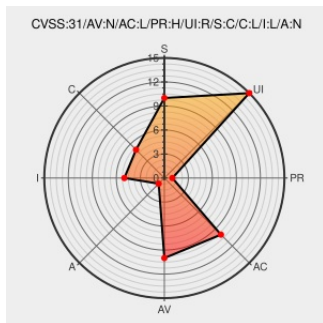

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Certain versions of [Chaoji Cms](#) from [Chaoji Cms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A stored cross site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in `/index.php?admin-master-article-edit` of Chaoji CMS v2.18 that allows attackers to obtain administrator privileges.

CVE-2020-18410 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
