

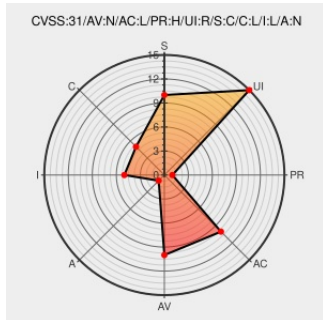

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability exists in bycms v3.0.4 via the title parameter in the edit function in Document.php.
