

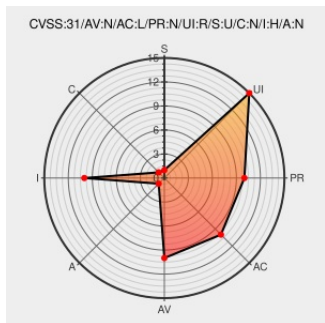

Certain versions of [Puppycms](#) from [Puppycms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in puppyCMS v5.1 that can change the admin's password via /admin/settings.php.

CVE-2020-18889 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
