

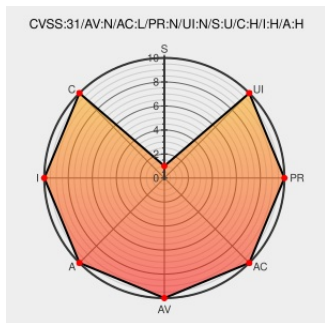

Certain versions of [Puppycms](#) from [Puppycms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Remote Code Execution (RCE) vulnerability in puppyCMS v5.1 due to insecure permissions, which could let a remote malicious user getshell via /admin/functions.php.

CVE-2020-18890 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
