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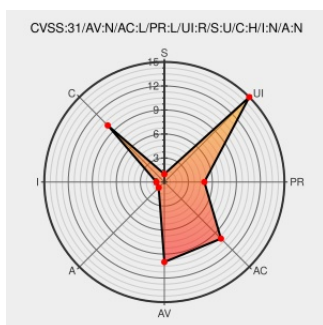

zrlog v2.1.0 has a vulnerability with the permission check. If admin account is logged in, other unauthorized users can download the database backup file directly.
