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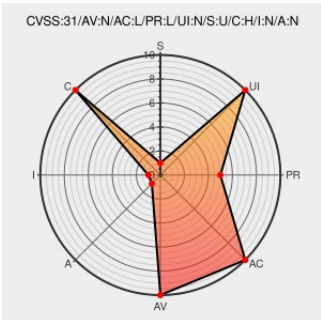

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Certain versions of **Jfinal Cms** from **Jflyfox** contain the following vulnerability:

Improper Access Control in Jfinal CMS v4.7.1 and earlier allows remote attackers to obtain sensitive information via the 'TemplatePath' parameter in the component 'jfinal_cms/admin/folder/list'.

CVE-2020-19146 has been assigned by [M cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
