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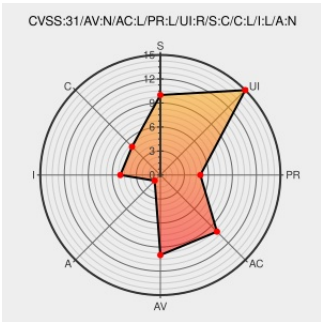

Certain versions of **Ari Adminer** from **Ari-soft** contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) in Ari Adminer v1 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via the 'Title' parameter of the 'Add New Connections' component when the 'save()' function is called.

CVE-2020-19156 has been assigned by [M cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
