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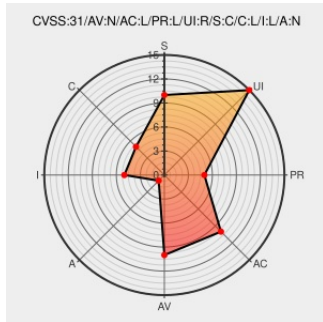

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Certain versions of **S-cms** from **S-cms** contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) in S-CMS build 20191014 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via the 'Site Title' parameter of the component '/data/admin/#/app/config/'.

CVE-2020-19158 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
