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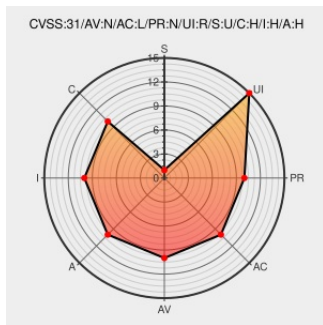

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Certain versions of [Laiketul](#) from [Laiketul](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Request Forgery (CSRF) in LaikeTui v3 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via the component `'/index.php?module=member&action=add'`.

CVE-2020-19159 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
