

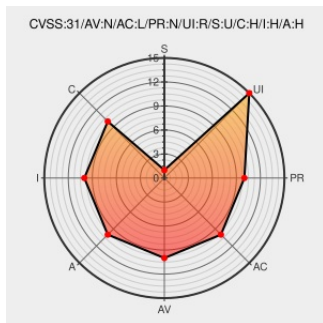

Certain versions of [Mipcms](#) from [Mipcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A cross-site request forgery (CSRF) in MipCMS v5.0.1 allows attackers to arbitrarily escalate user privileges to administrator via `index.php?s=/user/ApiAdminUser/itemEdit`.

CVE-2020-19263 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
