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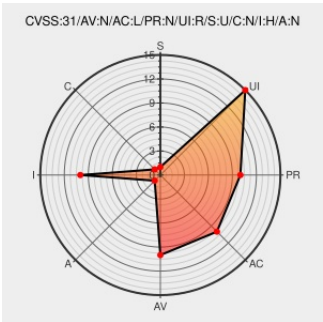

A cross-site request forgery (CSRF) in MipCMS v5.0.1 allows attackers to arbitrarily add users via `index.php?s=/user/ApiAdminUser/itemAdd`.
