Certain versions of [Dswjcms](#) from [Dswjcms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue in `index.php/Dswjcms/Basis/resources` of [Dswjcms 1.6.4](#) allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via uploading a crafted PHP file.

CVE-2020-19267 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
