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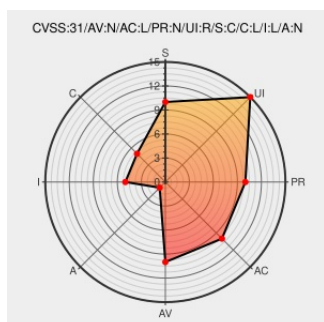

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Certain versions of [Dhcms](#) from [Dhcms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability exists in Dhcms 2017-09-18 in guestbook via the message board, which could let a remote malicious user execute arbitrary code.

CVE-2020-19274 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
