Certain versions of [Hdcms](#) from [Houdunren](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An arbitrary file upload vulnerability in `/fileupload.php` of `hdcms 5.7` allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted file.

CVE-2020-19303 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
