

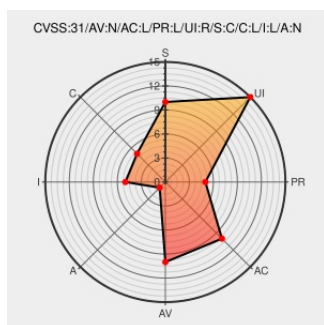

Certain versions of **Yellowfin Business Intelligence** from **Idera** contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability in configMap parameters in Yellowfin Business Intelligence 7.3 allows remote attackers to run arbitrary code via MIAdminStyles.i4 Admin UI.

CVE-2020-19587 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
