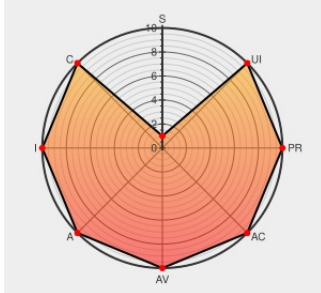

An issue found in Espruino Espruino 6ea4c0a allows an attacker to execute arbitrary code via oldFunc parameter of the jswrap_object.c:jswrap_function_replacewith endpoint.
