

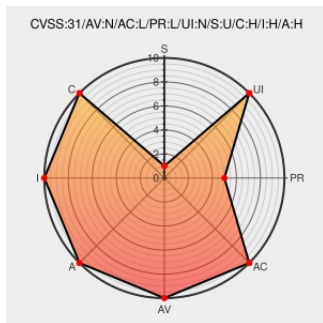

Certain versions of [Doyocms](#) from [Wdoyo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A SQL injection vulnerability in admin.php of DOYOCMS 2.3 allows attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the orders[] parameter.

CVE-2020-19821 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
