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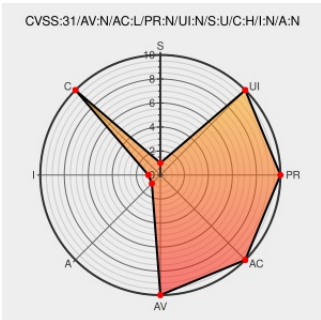

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Certain versions of [S-cms](#) from [S-cms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An XML External Entity (XXE) vulnerability was discovered in `/api/notify.php` in S-CMS 3.0 which allows attackers to read arbitrary files.

CVE-2020-19954 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
