

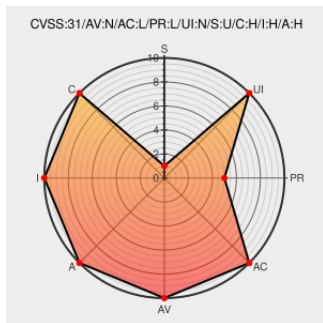

Certain versions of [Ibarn](#) from [Ibarn Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

File upload vulnerability in function upload in action/Core.class.php in zhimengzhe iBarn 1.5 allows remote attackers to run arbitrary code via avatar upload to index.php.

CVE-2020-20588 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
