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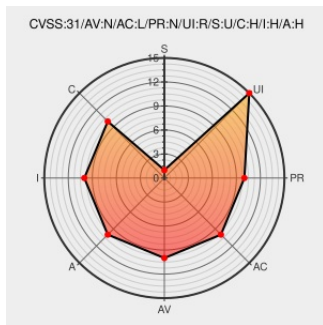

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Certain versions of [Zkeacms](#) from [Zkea](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An arbitrary file upload vulnerability in /admin/media/upload of ZKEACMS V3.2.0 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted HTML file.

CVE-2020-20670 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
