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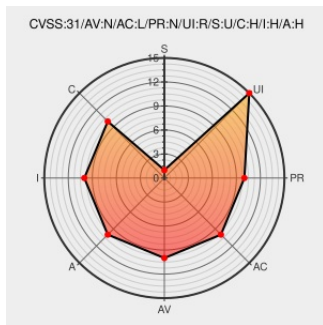

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Certain versions of [Gila Cms](#) from [Gilacms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) in GilaCMS v1.11.4 allows authenticated attackers to arbitrarily add administrator accounts.

CVE-2020-20693 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
