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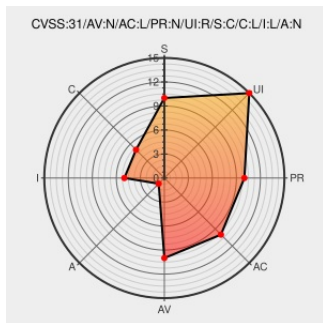

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Certain versions of [Zrlog](#) from [Zrlog](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross Site Scripting vulnerability in zrlog zrlog v.2.1.3 allows a remote attacker to execute arbitrary code via the nickname parameter of the /post/addComment function.

CVE-2020-21052 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
