

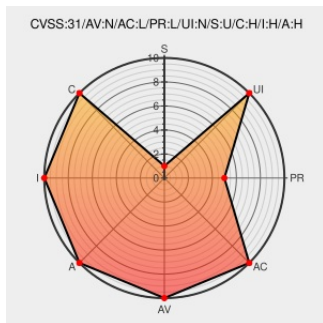

Certain versions of [Phpmywind](#) from [Phpmywind](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability found in PHPMYWind v.5.6 allows a remote attacker to gain privileges via the delete function of the administrator management page.

CVE-2020-21060 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
