

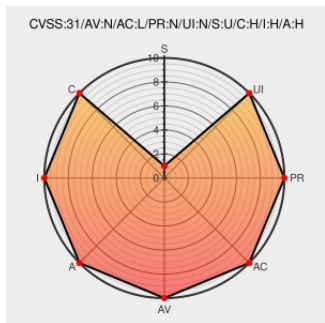

Certain versions of [Seacms](#) from [Seacms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in SeaCMS 10.1 (2020.02.08) via the id parameter in an edit action to admin\_members\_group.php.

CVE-2020-21378 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **9.8 - CRITICAL**
