

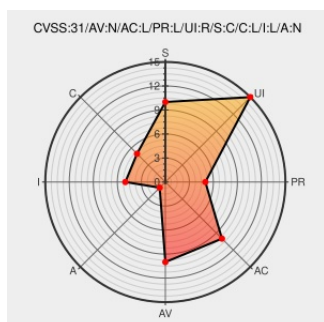

Certain versions of [Rgcms](#) from [Rgcms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in RGCMS v1.06 allows attackers to obtain the administrator's cookie via a crafted payload in the Name field under the Message Board module

CVE-2020-21482 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
