

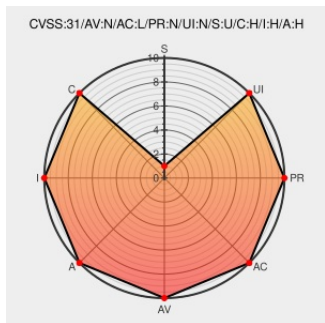

Certain versions of [Myucms](#) from [Myucms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Myucms v2.2.1 contains a remote code execution (RCE) vulnerability in the component `\controller\Config.php`, which can be exploited via the `addqq()` method.

CVE-2020-21652 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
