

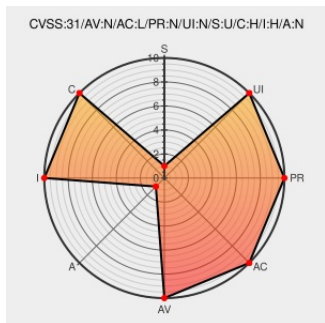

Certain versions of [Myucms](#) from [Myucms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Myucms v2.2.1 contains a server-side request forgery (SSRF) in the component `\controller\index.php`, which can be exploited via the `sj()` method.

CVE-2020-21653 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
