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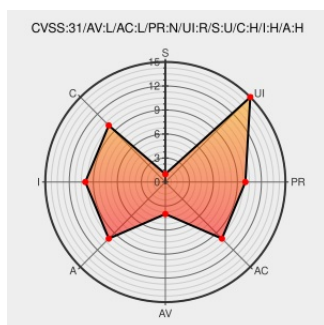

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Certain versions of [Ogg Video Tools](#) from [Ogg Video Tools Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer Overflow vulnerability in ExtractorInformation function in streamExtractor.cpp in oggvideotools 0.9.1 allows remote attackers to run arbitrary code via opening of crafted ogg file.

CVE-2020-21724 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
