

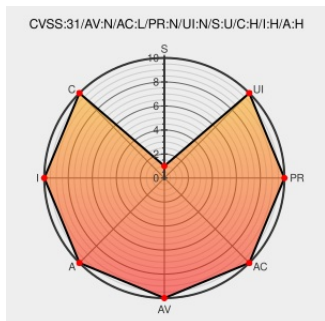

Certain versions of [Pdfcrack](#) from [Pdfcrack Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in pdfcrack 0.17 thru 0.18, allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a stack overflow in the MD5 function.

CVE-2020-22336 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
