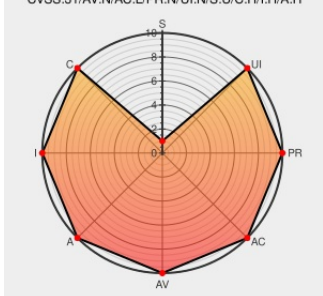

Certain versions of [Jerryscript](#) from [Jerryscript](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue in Jerryscript- project Jerryscript v. 2.3.0 allows a remote attacker to execute arbitrary code via the `ecma_builtin_array_prototype_object_slice` parameter.

CVE-2020-22597 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
